

Bay Area Soccer Association Referee Rebate Policy

Acknowledging that the referees who officiate games for the Bay Area Soccer Association are an asset to the organization, and as such to assist them in maintaining their referee certification, the Bay Area Soccer Association Board of Directors has established the "Referee Rebate Program". The intent of this rebate is that it be used to help defray the cost of yearly referee recertification.

The Referee Rebate shall only be paid out only once each calendar year, after the completion of the Fall Soccer Season. It shall be for those referees who meet the qualifications stated below. The Referee Rebate amount shall be \$35.

To qualify for the Referee Rebate, referees shall:

- 1. Officiate at least eight (8) games for BASA during a calendar year.
- 2. Officiate games covering at least five (5) different weekends during a calendar year.

It shall be the responsibility of the Referee Coordinator/Assignor to keep a list of the number of games and the dates officiated by each referee. After the Spring Season, the Referee Coordinator/Assignor shall inform each referee of their status, if they qualify, and if not, what they need to do to qualify in the fall.
